We are excited about being with them. Brother Ed was a deacon with us at Maranatha Baptist Church on Okinawa and worked with us as assistant pastor three years before going to Sasebo.

We are to leave Japan on July 6. We will have until July 15 to take care of business and be gone again. Our next opportunity to serve our Lord will be in Koolau Baptist Church in Hawaii. We are to leave July 15 for Hawaii. We will be filling in and assisting them in getting a pastor. There is much to be done in getting ready for a pastor. We are excited about this opportunity and desire your prayers. We want to do a good job and please the Lord.
