It started out with two months in Yokosuka, Japan, just after the terrible 9.0 earthquake, tsunami, and the nuclear disaster. The disaster in Japan is ever present with me, and my heart goes out to the Japanese people that were affected by this great tragedy. Yokosuka Baptist Church is doing great with missionary Ed Navato. Frankie and I were in Germany for two months. We were sent to Bethel Baptist Church in Stuttgart, Germany. This was also a very trying situation. The missionary was leaving the field and the church did not have any members or any money. The Lord blessed again and we were able to get out of the lease, pay the bills, move the furnishing out, and clean up the building. BIMI was left with a good testimony. Closing a church is something I never want to experience again. However, a new missionary can go in with a new church and a new location and do a great work there. We are thankful to Rusty and Karen Pilalas for allowing us to stay in their home during this time, and thanks to Tom Lancaster for the use of his van.

We arrived home from Germany on Monday, October 17, and Tuesday we received a call; missionary Russell Turner in Cayman Brac needed someone to fill in for him immediately. Brother Turner informed us that it would be difficult getting tickets on such a short notice, but he needed us there as soon as possible. The Lord worked in this and we were able to fly out Saturday morning, October 22. We were able to use our sky-miles to Grand Cayman Island, and there we purchased tickets to Cayman Brac. Brother Turner and his wife were able to return to the States for a few weeks.

We are enjoying our time here. Brother Turner has some wonderful people in his church. Frankie and I have had plenty of time to sit under the coconut trees and the almond trees and watch the ocean waves. We have enjoyed the ministry and have seen the Lord work in hearts and lives. Our services have been great and the Lord has been working. We are to leave Cayman Brac November 18.
