As we write this prayer letter, Frankie and I are filling in for Missionaries Ed and Elvy Navato at Yokosuka Baptist Church in Japan. This is a great church to the U.S. Military, and they also have an effective outreach to the Japanese. This is my seventh time preaching meetings and filling in at this church. The members here are dedicated and excited about serving the Lord, and this is a special place to us. I was here last year after the earthquake, tsunami, and nuclear disaster. When I arrived, it looked as if the church would have to close. There were only 12 to 14 people in the church and the base had been evacuated. It was a scary time for all of us. The Lord blessed and now the church is doing great. The people love their pastor and are excited about the work here. They are also excited about reaching folks for Christ. They are very active in soul winning and "tracting" near the base. In the past few weeks while soul winning outside the base, we have had one profession of faith and have had visitors come to church from the "tracting."



One of the Japanese ladies that was saved last year, after the disaster, is now one of the church's pianists. A Filipino lady that was saved last year had a desire to see her family in the Philippines saved, so she asked the church secretary to go with her to the Philippines to witness to her family. Week before last they flew to the Philippines and at first they were discouraged because of the flooding. Knowing that the Lord had burden their hearts about doing this, they started praying about getting all the family together. In spite of the flooding, they were able to come together at her parents' house. After hearing her testimony and Ruby presenting the gospel, nine of her family members were saved, including her parents.

Several of the ships are out at sea, but that is just another opportunity for this church to minister to the people. On board these ships Yokosuka Baptist Church has services. These faithful men are preaching and holding Bible studies while deployed. One of the single men of the church, when in port, brings several of his co-workers with him to church. One of the men who is very faithful with the "tracting" and soul winning outside the base is very excited with the opportunity to witness and give out tracts to friends and co-workers, which he cannot do on base.



On August 4, Frankie and I celebrated our 50th wedding anniversary. The wonderful people at Yokosuka Baptist Church surprised us with a marvelous 50th anniversary dinner. This was a wonderful surprise, and we felt very special with the love that the people showed toward us. Our thanks and heartfelt gratitude to them. Please continue to pray for us as we fill in here. Next we go to Okinawa, Japan, for a missions revival at Maranatha Baptist Church with Missionary Bob Montieth.
