Nutts' Notes–Nutts About Missions

As we approach the new year, Frankie and I are reflecting on how good the Lord has been to us over the years. What a great opportunity to serve our LORD in countries all over the world. Being missionaries to our US Military is a great honor. From the depths of our hearts we thank you for your prayer and financial support. A special thank you to all of you who have sent special offering throughout the year.

As many of you know, September 29 we flew to Japan as interim pastor for Yokosuka Baptist Church. This is a church to our US Military outside Yokosuka Naval Base. This is the largest naval base outside the United States. Two hours and 20 minutes out from Tokyo, Frankie had a stroke on the plane. We were very blessed of the Lord there was a doctor, nurse, and former Air Force man with medial training on the plane. When paged, these three people responded and went to work on Frankie saving her life. We are grateful to the Lord and to these people. Delta had an ambulance waiting at the airport when we landed. Frankie was taken to a hospital in Tokyo and released later that night.

This was not the only miracle. Our first Sunday, October 1, at Yokosuka Baptist Church we set up a pulpit committee. When meeting with the pulpit committee, they wanted to go ahead and try to find a missionary pastor while we were there. This looked impossible, but the Lord went to work immediately. The pulpit committee was presented with two prospects. They prayerfully picked a candidate and went to work checking him out. On October 22, BIMI Missionary Mike Pinson preached and came before the pulpit committee for examination. Then he was presented to the men of the church. The pulpit committee and the men of the church voted to put him before the church the next Sunday, October 29. The members could vote by email or in person. The church voted 100% to call Missionary Pastor Mike Pinson as pastor.

Pastor Pinson is a BIMI missionary on deputation for Military Missions. He needs to get to the field as soon as possible. As soon as Frankie was able to fly we returned to the United States on October 30. November 3, Missionary Chris Parker flew in and became interim pastor of Yokosuka Baptist Church until Pastor Pinson can get there. Update on Frankie: We have now heard from her neurologist and tests. Results from the spinal tap show Frankie will have to take two different prescription medicines. The neurologist also referred Frankie to a heart doctor. The heart doctor will insert a long term internal heart monitor. Please continue to pray for her.
